OFFICIAL RULES AND REGULATIONS SATURDAY, JULY 31, DOWNTOWN PARIS, TN BENEFITTING R.E.A.L. HOPE YOUTH CENTER

1. Each team is allocated one 10' X 10' outside space. Each team must provide its own table (required) and shelter (if desired).
2. Half-cup containers, spoons, freezer trucks for ice cream, promotion, picnic tables, music and trash cans will be the responsibility of the DPA.
3. Unless your team makes prior arrangements with the committee, your booth location will be assigned by the committee.
4. No electricity is available.
5. Entry forms must be received by Friday, June 11, 2010.
6. In lieu of tickets, silicone bracelets will be sold for a minimum donation of \$10 for adults and \$5 for children under twelve years of age. Each team is asked to pre-sell 40 bracelets.
7. Each team is responsible for bringing 15 gallons of ice cream. Homemade ice cream is encouraged but not required.
8. Homemade ice cream must not be made with raw eggs.
9. Ice cream containers should be labeled with group name for freezer truck storage.
10. Teams should check in at the DPA booth on the north side of the Court House between noon and 2:00 pm.
11. If it rains, all teams will be expected to set up at Ketchum Hall on South Poplar Street next to Grace Episcopal Church.
12. Prizes awarded for the Best Ice Cream, Best Theme and Best of Show.
13. Booth partners do not have to limit themselves to cups of ice cream; floats, cones, etc. are acceptable. Ice cream booth partners may also hold bake sales, coffee/water sales, etc., with proceeds donated to the beneficiary.

14. Booth partners are invited to share their approved outreach messages.
